Witches and bats fly into the night

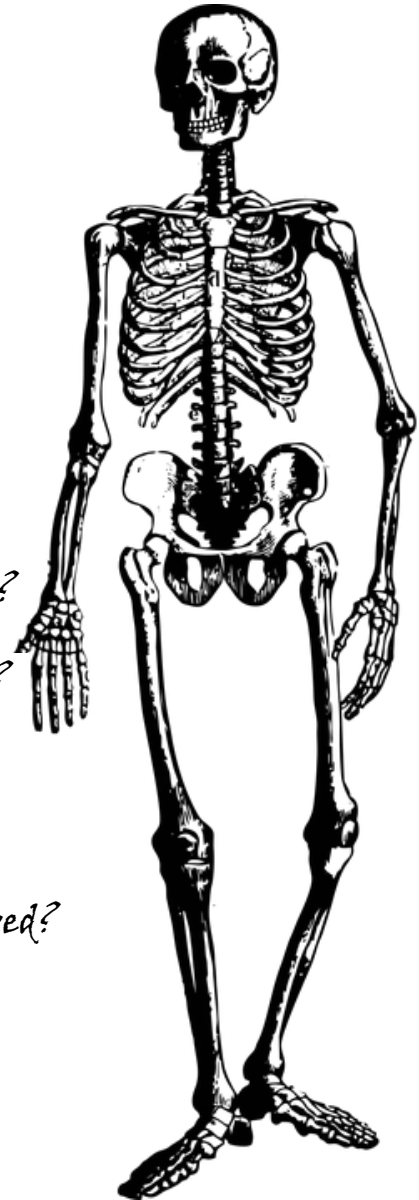
Who knows what will happen when the sun goes to bed?
